PLAYFUL MOVEMENTS WITH KATIE AND KELSEY

Picnic Basket		The top of the basket supports shape sorting and coordination skill development. This set also encourages imaginative play with food, drink, and utensils. Additionally, the butterfly feature on the side poses questions to promote problem-solving abilities and the ability to follow directions.
Magnetic Tiles		Magnetic tiles offer versatile play options, including stacking, building structures like castles, or attaching to magnetic surfaces such as refrigerators, magnetic boards, walls, doors, or baking sheets. This encourages children to develop problem-solving skills, creativity, and coordination as they determine where and how to place the tiles to create new designs.
Shopping cart		Pushing heavier objects in the shopping cart helps build core strength, while steering the cart enhances coordination and motor planning skills. The shopping cart also promotes imaginative play, allowing children to engage in pretend shopping for groceries, toys, and more.
Piggy bank		The coins help little ones develop grasping skills, encourage banging them together—a key developmental milestone—and are often used for sensory exploration through chewing. For older children, it promotes coordination as they work to place the coin in the slot and also strengthens reaching skills.
Squigz		Squigz offer versatile play and learning opportunities, including sorting by color, size, and number of sides. They can adhere to a wide range of surfaces such as walls, floors, and other toys, allowing for creative and engaging play. Children can also connect Squigz to form strings or shapes, enhancing coordination skills and fostering imaginative play.
3-in-1 sports center		Designed to grow with your toddler, offering years of engaging play. Featuring basketball, golf, and soccer, it provides a variety of activities to help children develop object manipulation and coordination skills, such as stepping into a ball, rolling, and extending arms to catch—all typically emerging around ages 1-2. The basketball hoop's height can be adjusted to accommodate different sizes, ensuring a perfect fit as your child grows.
DJ bouncin beats		Develops coordination skills by encouraging kids to press buttons. It offers an unstable surface for babies to interact with while seated, fostering dynamic balance. It encourages crawling or scooting as it moves when music plays, promoting mobility. Its interactive design also supports cause-and-effect learning.
Animal Barn Toys		This activity set promotes coordination through placing and removing lids on boxes, as well as taking out animal figures. It helps with color and number matching on the sides of the barn, enhancing recognition skills. Additionally, it encourages finger isolation through the use of finger puppets, aiding dexterity. Imaginative play is fostered with engaging animal sounds and interactions.
